Permission is hereby granted to <u>EGSci Consulting</u>. In front of <u>Intersection</u> of <u>Church Street</u> and <u>Sycamore Street</u>. For the purpose of <u>Evaulate and investigate sinkhole adjacent to Marta Decatur Station</u>. Work to be done between the hours of 9am-4pm, Monday April 6, 2015 and ending no later than Sunday April 11, 2015. Provide Traffic control plan per MUTCD and attached phased plans and notify Decatur PD on daily lane closures @ 404-373-6551. All possible street and sidewalk cuts will be repaired to City of Decatur specifications.

Work to be done and street to be restored to the satisfaction of the Engineering Department. Contractor to follow city standard details and Georgia DOT specifications on all construction and restoration work. Dirt shall not be stockpiled on the street or right-of-way. Proper soil erosion and siltation control measures to be implemented and maintained at all times.

In accepting this permit from the *City of Decatur*, the applicant assumes all liability for any and all injuries and damages sustained by any user of said street while work is in progress, and the applicant further agrees that he will be responsible for the proper lighting, barricading where necessary, and maintenance of street cuts until The Permanent Repairs Have Been Made.

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant to follow steps to ensure Performance Bond Refund. This portion of Right-of- Way permit must be signed and returned to Design, Environment & Construction Division, along with Final Inspection Request to begin process for Bond Refund. AFTER Final Inspection has passed please allow 4-6 weeks for bond to be returned by mail to the applicant.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. <u>Street Bores:</u> Street cut shall be kept to a minimum. Service laterals to be bored.
- 2. <u>Dirt:</u> All dirt shall be hauled off and brought back as needed. No pipe, dirt, asphalt, sand, asphalt, etc. shall be stock piled on any City right-of-way. Sidewalks and roadways must be cleaned immediately after construction work is completed.
- 3. <u>Traffic:</u> If site involves lane closures, provide adequate barricades, flaggers, or off duty police officers to handle traffic at all times. At least one lane of traffic shall be open at all times, if this is not feasible, you must request permission to close the street, post adequate detour signs and barricades and notify the Decatur police department (404) 373-6551.
- 4. <u>Start of Work: If site involves lane closures</u>, notify the Decatur police Department (404) 373-6551 and this office at least 24 hours before the start of work. Prior to pouring concrete submit Engineering Inspection Request to Engineering Inspector.
- 5. This permit is valid 30 days from the date of issuance. If work is not commenced within this time period the permit will expire.
- 6. Restoration work at each excavation shall commence upon completion of the excavation or as soon as practicable thereafter. Do not wait until the entire project is completed to begin excavation work.
- 7. Pavement restoration shall be in accordance with City standards, which includes benching back one foot on either side of the trench and Georgia DOT standards. No trench shall be left open overnight and shall be plated as required.
- 8. Changes: Any deviation from the approved plan must be approved by this office prior to implementation.
