







### **Unique Behavior Events by Gender**


Multiple genders can be involved in one unique event









## **Unique Behavior Events by Gender**




Multiple races can be involved in one unique event










# **Behavior Events: Weapons**

The counts above include events coded as Weapons-Other, Weapons-Knife, Weapons-Handgun, Weapons-Rifle, and Other Firearms.

The top number represents the unique count of event IDs.

The number in parentheses is the difference over the prior year.
